Sanchez and expert panelists will discuss how the proposed Social Security changes will affect Americans nationwide

WHAT: U.S. Representative Loretta Sanchez (D-Garden Grove) will host a town hall forum on the Bush Administration's proposed restructuring of Social Security. Expert panelists from AARP and CSUF will also be available to answer questions from the public.

Recent opinion polls signal discontent with President Bush's proposed changes. In February, a USA TODAY/CNN/Gallup Poll found that 59% of those surveyed said Social Security doesn't need to be changed right away.
