February 28, 2002 Rep. Sanchez Receives Perfect Voting Score
From AAUW For First Session Of 107th Congress

WASHINGTON, D.C. - In its Preliminary Voting Record for the first session of the 107th Congress, the American Association of University Women (AAUW) gave Congresswoman Loretta Sanchez a perfect score for her votes on legislation identified as important to AAUW. The specific legislation included in report was selected on the basis of AAUW's public policy priorities and principles as adopted by AAUW convention delegates in 1999 and 2001.

"These voting records are good barometers for constituents with particular interests to monitor various members of Congress and their performance as legislators," said Sanchez "My voting record has always been aligned with issues important to women and the AAUW, but this report card helps illustrate that."

It is expected that Congress will continue to consider AAUW's priority issues through the remainder of the 107th Congress. By using the Preliminary Voting Record, AAUW members and other concerned citizens can hold their senators and representatives accountable for how they vote on those issues.
